Advantages

- ATAWADAC: AnyTime, AnyWhere, Any Device, Any Content
- Use presential time for special aims
- Motivate learners by using other methods
- Motivate learners by using the devices they are used to

Disadvantages

- Time-consuming preparation
- Costs (depending on tools)
- Sometimes difficult to develop
- Often seen as a way to reduce training costs and replace presential courses
